NOTICE TO PROPOSERS

Notice is hereby given that the Housing Authority of the County of Merced, hereinafter known as the "Authority", is soliciting appropriately licensed with the California State Licensing Board (CSLB), qualified contractors to provide all work necessary to complete the work as detailed within the Scope of Work (SOW). The work will be completed at the Developments known as Sierra Vista, located in Atwater, CA and O'Banion Terrace, located in Dos Palos, CA, all are located within Merced County.

The Authority is soliciting for four (4) separate projects:

- #2020-003: Sierra Vista Fence Project;
- #2020-004: O'Banion Terrace Asphalt Project;
- #2020-005: O'Banion Terrace Lighting Project;
- #2020-006: O'Banion Terrace Fence Project

It is the sole responsibility of the contractor to examine and inspect the fencing project, asphalt project and the lighting project in its entirety to provide complete and accurate proposal(s). Contractor(s) can bid on all four (4), three (3), two (2), or one (1) of the project(s). The proposal(s) shall be separate, clearly defined for each of the project(s) and not to be combined, or they will not be accepted.

Interested parties must submit one (1) set of signed proposal(s) in a envelope for each project to the Housing Authority of the County of Merced, 405 U Street, Merced, CA 95341, **prior to 2:00 pm (PDT) on Friday, February 28, 2020**, and clearly marked #2020-003: "Sierra Vista Fence Project", #2020-004: "O'Banion Terrace Asphalt Project", #2020-005: "O'Banion Terrace Lighting Project" or #2020-006: "O'Banion Terrace Fence Project".

The U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) have determined that this job requires compliance with the Davis-Bacon Act and Related Acts and the payment of not less than the prevailing wages as determined by the DOL for the Fencing and Exterior Lighting project(s). You may also obtain a current wage determination by visiting <https://beta.sam.gov/>. Wage decision issued by DOL #CA202009, Mod. #3, issued 01/30/2020, will be utilized for the project(s). Wage decision shall be "locked-in" ten (10) days prior to the proposal opening. Attention is called to the "Notice of Requirement for Affirmative Action to insure Equal Employment Opportunity" (Executive Order #13658).

The Authority reserves the right to sole and exclusive judgment in the determination of the qualifications of each proposer. The Authority reserves the right to reject any and/or all proposals, and further reserves the right to waive any informalities or irregularities in the proposals, or to accept or select any proposal that the Authority, in its sole and absolute discretion, determines best meets the Authority needs.
